

UEN Crime Watch Patrol Meeting Notes 11/08/2011

This was a consolidated meeting with CP16 representing the Foxboro / Fairways of Sherrill Park area and CP19 representing Crowley Park. The meeting was at the Police substation on Renner Road.

Officer Mike Wiczorek represented RPD.

RPD Comments:

- RPD statistics on recent activity were presented:
 - Fairways/Foxboro had no incidents in the last month
 - Crowley Park several incidents, including multiple thefts due to open garage doors and 2 incidents of theft of wheels/tires
 - UEN had two incidents – a property vandalism and a vehicle break-in.
- Wheel/tire theft incidents are on a noticeable increase in the Breckenridge area. The thieves are typically parking in a driveway next door to the target vehicle.
- SE Richardson is seeing a significant increase in vehicle break-ins for the purpose of stealing a garage door clicker to make entry into a home.
- Vacant homes for sale are being targeted for theft of appliances.
- A burglary of a home was stopped by a resident after thieves knocked on his door, then went across the street for another try. He watched them attempt to force the door and called RPD. The CWP patrol was in the area and the thieves left, but then returned after the CWP patrol was gone. RPD arrived in time to arrest the thieves.

Other Discussion:

October was a light month for our team – we did not make the city request for a minimum of 16 hours of patrol. We had 12 patrols for 12.5 hours of actual patrol time. 11 members contributed a total of 29.75 hours to our neighborhood safety.

November is off to a slow start with only 3 patrols to-date as of Thursday.

Meetings:

We will continue on the second Tuesday of each month for next year. All meetings are set for the substation at 6:30 pm.
